Q1. Prepare a science magazine on the theme environment. Some of the things that you could put in the magazine are-

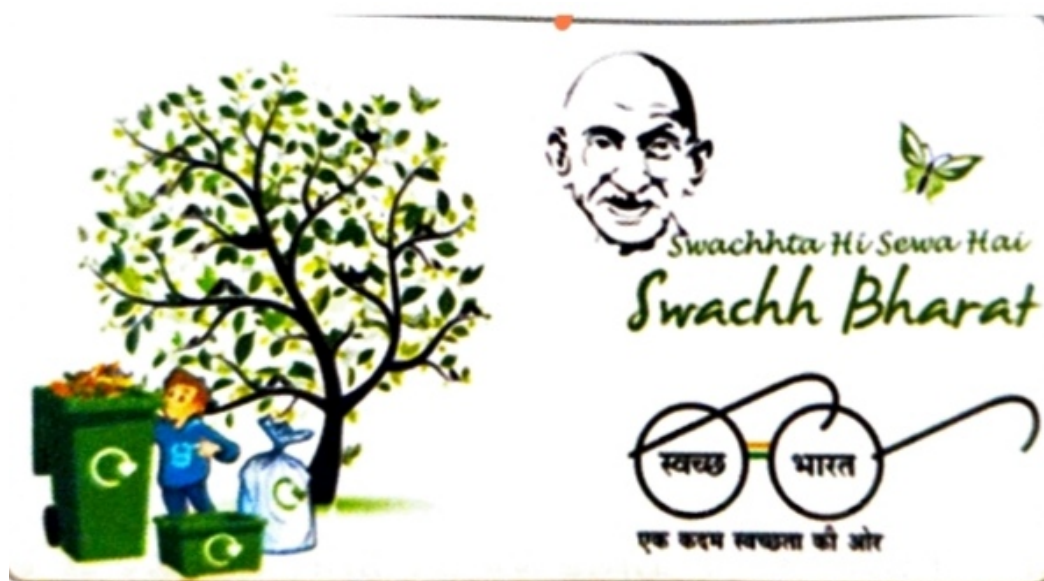
- a) Famous environmentalist (their pictures and information about their work).

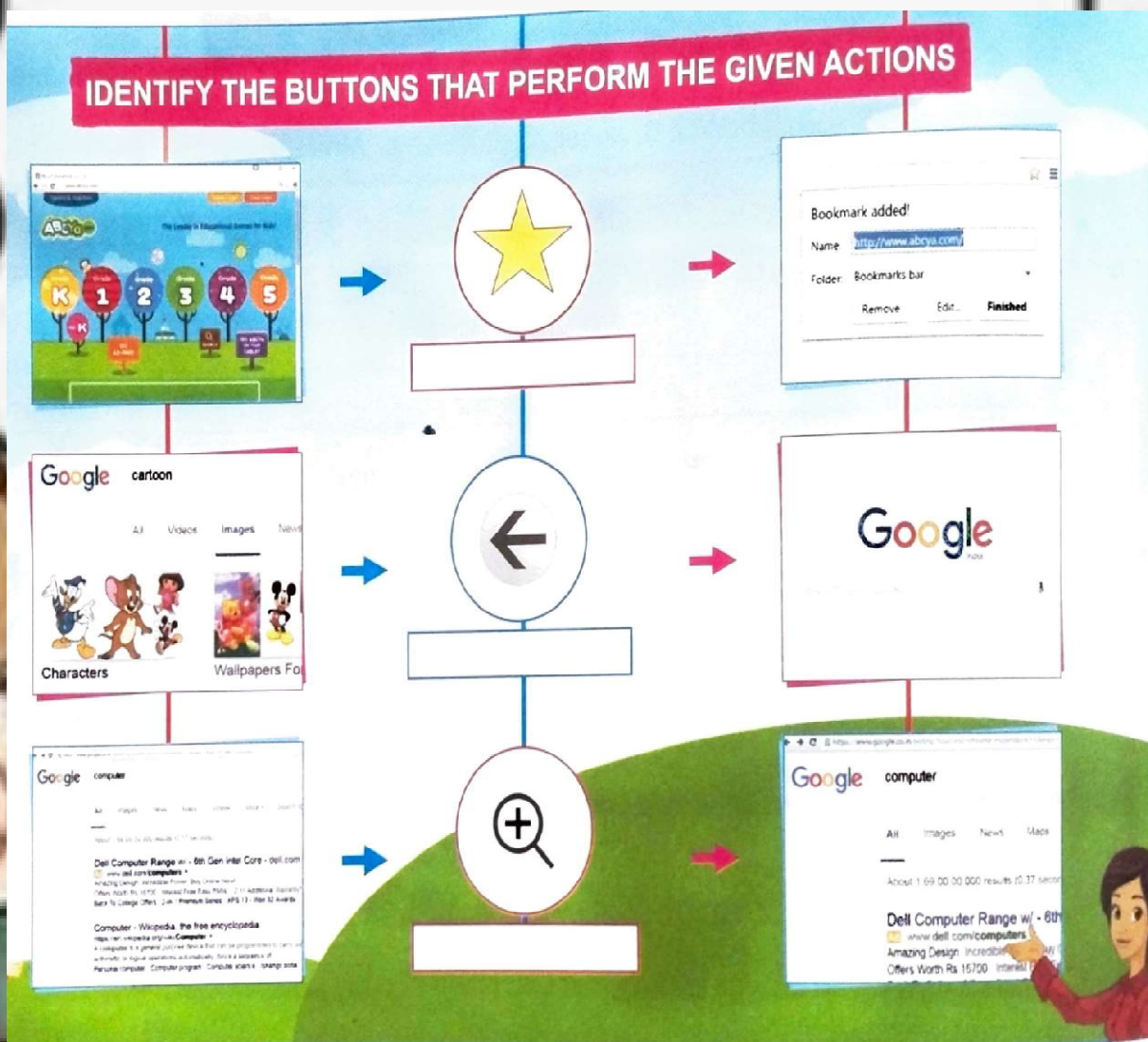
Q3- Find out about the food habits of people in your native place. Collect pictures and make a table of it.
